2. Provide proof of status as a rising junior or senior undergraduate student at an accredited college or university OR be a student at an accredited theological school or school of Christian Education.
3. Provide proof of grade point average of 2.0 or better.
4. Provide letter of recommendation by one of your professors from the most appropriate department (i.e. Religion, Religious Studies) stating your potential to become a successful minister of the Gospel.
5. Complete this application and return it to the United Methodist Foundation of Western North Carolina, Inc. with the items listed above before the deadline.
